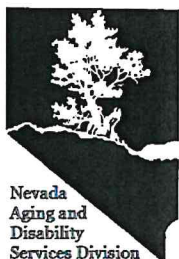
Walks are held every Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. and will begin and end at the Truckee Meadows Parks Foundation office in Idlewild Park, located at
